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

ATTENDANCE



We know that pupils fall behind their friends and classmates when they miss school. At St Vincent's we want the amount of missed education to be reduced as much as possible. We believe that our community is stronger together, with all of our pupils in school, on time, every day. We are building life skills, life-long friendships and preparing your child for future success.

We would really appreciate your help and support ensuring that pupils come to school every day so that they can get the best possible outcomes. We want to work with you to achieve this.

We have recently received several requests for holidays. Holidays in term time are not authorised and are recorded as such. The end and start of school term is very important and even with one day of absence pupils can miss important information and learning.

We know that sometimes our pupils cannot come to school because they are very unwell - and that's the right thing to do for them and other pupils.

Schools are issued with NHS guidance. Medical advice is clear however it states that children with mild illness will often be well enough to attend - for example if they have a cough, or cold, without a temperature.
