new King

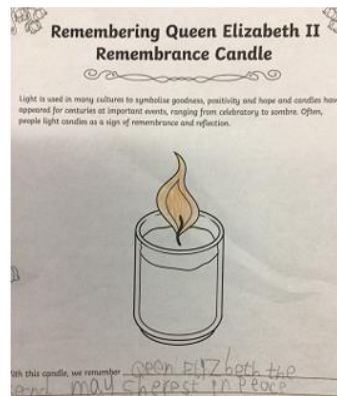


Dear God,

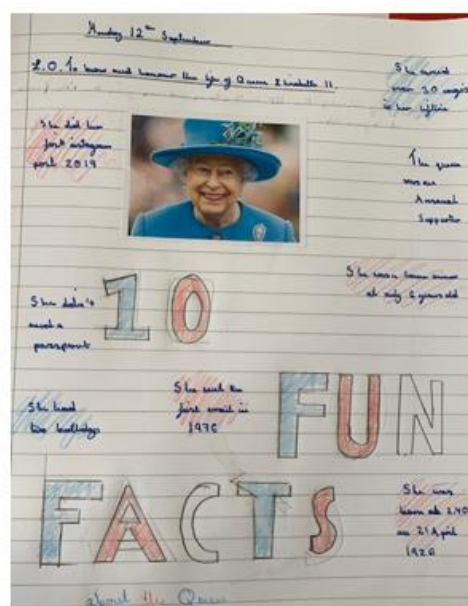
