

## Key Stage 2 Assessments 2018

Children in Year 6 have taken tests in maths, reading and grammar, punctuation and spelling. Teacher assessment judgements have been given in writing. The test results are given as a scaled score for each subject. A scaled score of 100 means a child is working at the expected standard for the end of the key stage.
