Year 1 Phonics Screening Check 2022-2023

The phonics screening check tests a child's ability to decode words using only their phonic knowledge. It helps to confirm whether they have met the expected phonic standard for the end of Year 1.

The check is a statutory requirement for all children in Year 1 and takes place in the summer term. Children who did not take the check in Year 1, or who did not meet the expected standard, take the check again at the end of Year 2.
