## HOW THE MONEY'S BEEN SPENT SO FAR

Each classroom has been provided with an **interactive globe** to enrich the children's geography learning. They have loved using them to find out facts about different countries.

The willow tree tunnel with nature fact boards, bug hotels and tree stump seating provides a lovely setting for outdoor learning. The allotment is now ready to use, with lots of bulbs planted and waiting to bloom throughout the year.

We have paid for the Christmas pantomime and Christmas present books.

We funded zones of regulation 'colour monster' toys for sensory activities.
