


Happy New Year! I hope you had a peaceful Christmas and enjoyed spending time with your family.

On Monday we celebrated the feast of the Epiphany and held an assembly about this special feast day. Please see an Epiphany prayer below.





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


DFE SCHOOL PERFORMANCE TABLES
