LENT

School Values: Make a Difference Be Passionate about Learning Be Kind Be Respectful



Thank you to Canon Jonathan who came into school to celebrate Ash Wednesday Mass with us. During the special season of Lent, we will share the Easter story. The children know that Lent is a time to grow closer to God and learn how to be more loving and generous, both to God and to others. Here is how your children will be learning about and participating in this special season:

- a. **Prayer**: During Lent, we will encourage the children to take small steps to grow in their relationship with God. They will be learning simple prayers and ways to talk to God throughout their day. We will also have opportunities for them to pray together with their friends and families.
- b. Acts of Kindness: Instead of only focusing on what we give up, we will emphasise what we can give to others. The children will be encouraged to look for small ways to show kindness, whether that's helping a friend, sharing a smile, or offering a prayer for someone in need.
- c. **Fasting in a Child-Friendly Way**: We teach the children how to "fast" by giving up something small but meaningful. This might be something like giving up extra screen time or choosing to play quietly so that they have more time for prayer and reflection.
- d. **Almsgiving**: We will talk about how we can help others during Lent. By raising money for a charity, our children will learn that giving isn't just about money, it's about giving of our time and kindness.

Purple Wednesday

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Following our St. Vincent's tradition, each Wednesday will be 'Purple Wednesday'. Pupils will be encouraged to wear a purple accessory. This could be a belt, bobble, hairband, friendship band, socks or tights.



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Purple is used for two reasons: firstly, because it is associated with mourning and so anticipates the crucifixion, and secondly because purple is the colour associated with royalty and celebrates Christ's resurrection and sovereignty. #Be respectful


