Purple Wednesday

Following our St. Vincent's tradition, each Wednesday will be 'Purple Wednesday'. Pupils will be encouraged to wear an item of purple clothing. This could be an accessory such as a belt, bobble, hairband, loom band, socks or tights.

Purple is used for two reasons: firstly, because it is associated with mourning and so anticipates the pain and suffering of the crucifixion, and secondly because purple is the colour associated with royalty and celebrates Christ's resurrection and sovereignty.

Lenten Promises

Children will be making their Lenten promises over the next week. We try to think of others and focus on our thoughts and actions. Some of the children have spoken about doing this with their families too as a family Lenten promise.

A Lenten reflection for families will take place on Friday 7th March led by Year 4 at 9.05 am in the junior hall.

Children in Year 3 will host children from Our Lady of Lourdes and will visit All Saints Primary Schools for Lenten Liturgies in March.

CAFOD Family Fast Day Friday 14th March

On Friday 14th children will be asked to sacrifice their morning snack in return for a £1 donation to CAFOD through ParentPay.

Lent Love in Action Day Friday 21st March

On Lent Love in Action Day, every class will take on a charitable challenge to raise funds for their chosen charity. In preparation, over February half term, each child researched a charity of their choice as part of their homework. They then shared their findings with their class, and together, the class voted for the charity they will be supporting with their sponsored challenge.

This day is an opportunity for our children to live out our values of kindness and make a difference to the lives of others.

Prayer Trails and Stations of the Cross

In each department there will be a Lenten prayer trail where pupils will visit prayer stations and reflect on the journey that Jesus made and pray the Stations of the Cross. The stations will be displayed, and children will be led in a reflection by the Prayer Leaders and their teachers where they can observe and pray.

Lenten Buddy

The children will all be given a secret 'Lenten Buddy' from their class. During Lent, the children will be extra nice to their buddy and try to guess who their buddy is.

Lenten Fundraising

This Lent we will be taking part in the 'Big Lent Walk'. This year, we are fundraising for St Ann's Hospice in loving memory of Natasha Gee, honouring her and the incredible work of St Ann's. This will involve children and staff walking 200km during Lent using our daily mile track. Every child will walk with their class daily throughout Lent to meet this target collectively.
